

Directions for Use — Pre-Stained Morphology Slides

General chamber preparation for hematology testing




Step 1: Apply a small drop (approximately ~2-4 microliters) of specimen on the center of the slide.

Warning: EDTA is the recommended anticoagulant for venous blood. Oxalae, flouride and heparinized blood are NOT suitable.



Step 2: Place the cover glass (24 x 24 mm or 24 x 40 mm) on top of the slide, exerting slight pressure on the coverglass.



Step 3: Allow the slide to stand at room temperature for 15 minutes before microscopic observation is made. The slides are used for evaluating sperm head/acrosome size, differentiation of white blood cells in peripheral blood and cytology of body fluids.

Expected Findings:

These slides are for evaluating sperm head/acrosome size, differentiation of white blood cells in peripheral blood and cytology of body fluids.
